Course: Outdoor 25 yard pool, Colorado Start System & two button Colorado System 5 Timing & Stopwatch Timing. 8 lanes will be used for the competition course at the discretion of the meet referee. A Warm-up Area may be available throughout the duration of the meet. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C).

Eligibility:

1. Any currently registered 2010 USA swimmer as of the meet entry deadline.
2. Age on January 30th, 2010 will govern for the meet.
3. A current, valid USA Swimming registration card must be presented to the Clerk of Course if requested.
4. This is a No Time Standard meet.
5. No on-deck registration will be available.
6. Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or entry chairperson must alert the meet director, referee, and entry coordinator as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted.

Rules:

1. The current rules of USA competitive swimming will govern.
2. Individual events are pre-seeded timed final events, with the exception of the 400 IM, 500, 1000, and 1650 Freestyle. The 400 IM, 500, 1000, and 1650 Freestyle will require positive check-in prior to the start of the session.
3. Swimmers are limited to 4 events per session and 5 events per day.
4. Entry times must be the swimmer's best short course times.
5. All coaches and officials must be USA Swimming registered prior to the competition and wear current registration in a visible manner.
6. Positive Check-in for 400 IM, 500, 1000, and 1650 Freestyle events will close at the start of the session.
7. ANY events may be seeded functionally. Genders may be combined to accommodate time-line requirements.
8. Time Trials may be offered during session 2.
9. Arizona Swimming Inc. controlled meet warm-up will be posted & enforced.
10. Participating teams may be assigned lanes for timing
11. Swimmers must provide their own timer and lap counter for the 500, 1000 and 1650 freestyle
